## Opening of the online portal for submission of Online Application Form for UGC-NET December 2021 and June 2022 (merged cycles)

The NTA has been entrusted by the University Grants Commission (UGC) with the task of conducting UGC-NET, which is a test to determine the eligibility of Indian nationals for 'Assistant Professor' and 'Junior Research Fellowship and Assistant Professor' in Indian universities and colleges.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct UGC-NET December 2021 and June 2022 (merged cycles) for 'Junior Research Fellowship' and eligibility for 'Assistant Professor' in **82 subjects** in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.

The slots of JRF of both UGC-NET December 2021 & June 2022 cycles have been merged while the methodology for Subject wise cum Category-wise allocation of JRF remain unchanged.
