- 5. The Departmental and Institutional level Committees as per UGC (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulation, 2018 to be constituted.
- 6. University Librarian to upload all Ph.D. Theses of the University on Shodh Ganga and procure the

plagiarism check software 'Turnitin'.



7. Bridge courses/ value added courses should be offered to the undergraduates.

Establishment of Journal Clubs: An IQAC Initiative

What is a JOURNAL CLUB?

A journal club is a group of individuals who meet regularly to critically read, understand and evaluate recent papers/ articles published in research periodicals.

Aim of Journal Club

To provide its member with up-to date research literature; and act as a forum for teaching and learning the newer concepts, techniques and promote the importance of valid research findings into practice.

Benefits

- Expands the knowledge
- Improves reading habits by enabling critical thinking
- Learning presentation skill

- Facilitates acquisition of new techniques
- Induces scientific temperament by promoting an inquisitive attitude

Constitution of Journal Club

- 1. Head of Department to select a Director of Journal Club (HoD himself/herself or a Senior faculty member).
- 2. All Ph.D. supervisors in the department will be members of the Journal Club Board (JCB).
- 3. The Director of the Journal Club shall submit the constitution of JCB to the Academic Council through the Board of Studies (BoS) and to IQAC for information.

Methodology of Journal Club

- 1. JCB shall define the goals and lay out 'General Rules' of club.
- 2. JCB shall identify the thrust areas for Journal Club.
- 3. JCB shall prepare a schedule and select Research Papers/ Articles or else the Supervisors shall assign the same to the Research Scholars.
- 4. Research Scholars and PG students (if possible) shall participate in the presentations. On the basis of the performance of the presenter, some marks under Internal Assessment may also be allotted in Pre-Ph.D. Course.
- 5. A Report of the activities to be submitted to IQAC.
