**Sub: Statutory Scheme/ Rules and syllabus for B.Pharm and M.Pharm Courses.**

Sir/Madam

1. The Pharmacy Council of India, with the prior approval of the Central Government, has notified the following Education Regulations –
  - a. The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
  - b. The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.

These Regulations are also posted on the Council's website www.pci.nic.in

2. As per regulations 6 and 8 of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014, the course of study for B.Pharm course and syllabus for each subject of study shall be as may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
3. Similarly, as per regulation 10 of the Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014, the syllabus for each subject of study shall be as may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
4. Accordingly, the Council has prescribed the –
  1. Scheme and syllabus for M.Pharm Course.
  2. Rules and Syllabus for B.Pharm Course.

The same are available on Council's website www.pci.nic.in

5. The 100<sup>th</sup> Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held in November, 2016 has decided to instruct all Universities / Colleges to implement the same and submit compliance of implementation of the syllabus and regulations to PCI latest by 1st August, 2017.

In view of above, the institutions running above pharmacy courses and the examining authorities holding examination of pharmacy students are required to strictly follow the statutory provisions contained in the said Schemes/Rules for approval undersections 12(1) and 12 (2) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948. It may please be noted that further extension of approval of the pharmacy institutions u/s 12(1) and of the universities u/s 12 (2) of the said Act shall depend on the implementation of the course of study and syllabus prescribed by the PCI as mentioned above.

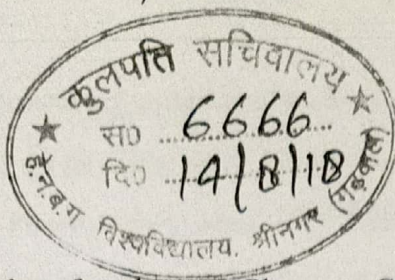

Subject: Regarding allocation of grade as per Pharmacy Council of India /University Ordinances  
Madam,

This has reference to Gazette of India notification No. 362, Dated 11 December 2014 and letter No. 14-136/2016-PCI/53895-55431, Dated 21 Dec. 2016 issued from Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), the B. Pharm. (04 years) and M. Pharm. (02 years) syllabus scheme of examination and ordinances prescribed by the PCI has been implemented with effect from 2017-18 academic session. (Letter from PCI regarding mandatory direction to comply the implementation of PCI approved B. Pharm. syllabus w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 is enclosed as Annexure-I). According to the rules & syllabus for the B. Pharm and M. Pharm course grading of performances shall be based on absolute conversion of letter grade and grade points equivalent for the percentage of marks but as per our university ordinances the same is relative. Due to this i.e., which evaluation system to adopt, the results of B. Pharm I, II and M. Pharm I, II sem has not been declared. Kindly give the direction to the concerned examination branch of the university for above matter and do the needful.


1. Name of the courses and their credit points as per the PCI syllabus guidelines for B.Pharm/M.Pharm (17. Grading of performances).


