Today on 4th November 2019 the IQAC organized two parallel sessions by United State-India Educational Foundation (USIEF) experts in the Birla Campus, Srinagar. **Dr. Gayatri Singhal**, India Program Manager, USIEF gave a presentation on **“Fulbright-Nehru and Fulbright Fellowship Opportunities to the U.S.”** in the Senate Hall.
