Since its inception, 2000, the branch name of the four year B. Tech. degree course was Instrumentation Engineering. To attract more students, the name of the course was changed to Electrical and Instrumentation Engineering in 2018. But during this span, it was observed that there was no significant enhancement in the strength of the student. Hence, it is proposed that the name of the branch be changed to its initial name, i.e., Instrumentation Engineering. More job oriented contents will be included to attract the students for admission to this branch.

The committee members opined that in the light of NEP. where there are multidisciplinary, multi choice avenues of the courses, multiple entries and exit options, the proposed name of the branch may be named as Instrumentation However, more automation, Engineering. Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) related courses may be included/ offered as open electives with the core courses. Hence the branch name is unanimously recommended to be as Instrumentation Engineering.
