This correction of the grading system in Ph.D. Ordinance shall be ensured by the Controller of Examinations, HNBGU before putting the draft for approval of the Executive Council.

The Council Members expressed their appreciation for the diligent efforts undertaken by Prof. A. K. Pandey, Chairperson and other members of the committee in drafting the University Ordinances.
