✚ Students shall have to appear in written examination consisting of 100 multiple choice question (MCQs) based on undergraduate syllabus of the concerned subject of this University for post graduate programs. A candidate can appear in Entrance Test for P.G. programs maximum in three subjects. Candidates applying for more than one PG programs need to mention it in the application form. ✚ Each question shall be of 01 mark and there shall be no negative marking.

- ✚ The students shall be allowed a maximum of two hours time to complete the test.
- ✚ For diploma/P.G. diploma programs, MCQ question paper shall be based on general knowledge, current affairs, aptitude and elementary knowledge about the subject.
- ✚ In case of Advance P.G. Diploma in Environmental Economics and P.G. Diploma in Environmental Management, MCQ question paper shall be based on the syllabus of M.Sc. Environmental Sciences of H.N.B. Garhwal University available on the University website.

- ✚ Those appearing in the final year examinations can also apply, subject to the condition that they will have to produce their final year result on or before the last date of admission.
