Hemvati Nandan Bahuguna Garhwal University, originally a state university, was converted into a Central University under the Central Universities Act, 2009. As per the provisions of

the Act, all colleges, institutions, and departments affiliated to, admitted to the privileges of, or maintained by Hemvati Nandan Bahuguna Garhwal University shall stand affiliated to the University.

In line with the University's policy, extension of temporary affiliation for existing affiliated colleges/institutions is carried out on a year-to-year basis, subject to inspection and fulfillment of prescribed norms and standards. Following the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Ministry of Education (MoE), the University has revised its academic structure accordingly. Under the revised framework:

- Undergraduate programmes aligned with NEP 2020 have been implemented across university campuses and affiliated colleges/institutes from the **academic session 2022–23.**
- Postgraduate programmes in line with NEP 2020 are scheduled to be implemented from the academic session 2025–26.

Accordingly, the affiliated colleges and institutions have been directed to implement the NEP 2020 structure within the existing approved courses/programmes and sanctioned seats.

The AC/EC in its earlier meeting resolved to maintain status-quo in the matter of affiliation. However, in compliance of the order of Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand dated 30.11.2023 in W/P No. WPMS No. 2851/2022 Pradeep Singh Vs State of Uttarakhand & Ors. and subsequent recommendation of the Inspection Committee constituted by the University for extension of temporary affiliation for **LL.M** (new course) from the academic session 2024-25 with certain conditions to be complied by the college. Accordingly, the college has submitted written response vide letter dated 3.10.2024 addressing the university's letter HNBGU/Manyata/2024/235 dated 3.7.2024.

As directed by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, the matter was earlier put up for recommendation of EC. However, meeting of EC could not be convened by the university.

The matter was put up before the Standing Committee on 16.04.2025 and on the

recommendation of the Standing Committee, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has directed to put up the matter before the EC. The matter related to affiliation of LL.M (new course) in Govt. Law College, Gopeshwar along with copy of order of Hon'ble High Court, and recommendation of Standing committee are placed before the council for deliberation and decision please.

However, this decision was challenged, and the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand granted a stay on the implementation of the Executive Council's resolution. Consequently, these colleges continue to remain affiliated with the University as of now. Following the stay order of the Hon'ble High Court, and in line with the directions of the Executive Council, the University has sought further guidance from the Ministry of Education. Meanwhile, the State Government is strongly advocating for the deaffiliation of these government-aided private colleges from HNBGU.

With the above reference, the University has submitted facts regarding actions taken on the issue to the MoE vide letter No. HNBGU/VC/2025/480 dated 09.08.2025.
