**Second Counseling for Admission to the LL.M. Programme

All candidates who appeared in the University Entrance Test (UET) for admission to the LL.M. program held in June 2026 and who have paid and registered themselves on the SAMARTH Portal for admission to the Department of Law, BGR Campus, Pauri, Pauri Garhwal, are hereby informed that the second phase counselling for the remaining vacant seats in the LL.M. programme will be held as per the following schedule:

Only those candidates who report for second counselling will be considered for admission. Appearance at the second counselling does not guarantee admission to the LL.M. programme. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the second counselling.

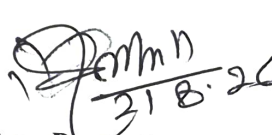
Candidates must **mandatorily** bring the following **original** documents along with a complete set of self-attested photocopies:

- High School Marksheet (as proof of Date of Birth);
- Intermediate Marksheet;
- Graduation Marksheet;
- LL.B. / Integrated Five-Year Law Marksheet (Candidates must have secured more than 50% in LL.B. 3-year/ Law Integrated Courses for all categories);
- Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate, Character Certificate (not more than six months old), and Gap Certificate (if applicable);
- Category Certificate(s): SC / ST / OBC (in the Government of India format for the preceding financial year), EWS (latest), and NCC / NSS / Sports certificates (if applicable). The OBC and EWS certificates must have been issued after 31 March 2026 and must be in the prescribed Central Government format;
- NCC / NSS / Sports / Extra-Curricular Activities Certificates (if claiming weightage);
- One printed copy of the online application form generated through the SAMARTH Portal; and
- UET Score Card.

Candidates are advised to carefully verify their eligibility before appearing for counselling. In view of the prevailing weather conditions in the State, candidates are strongly advised to reach the campus one day prior to the date of counselling.
